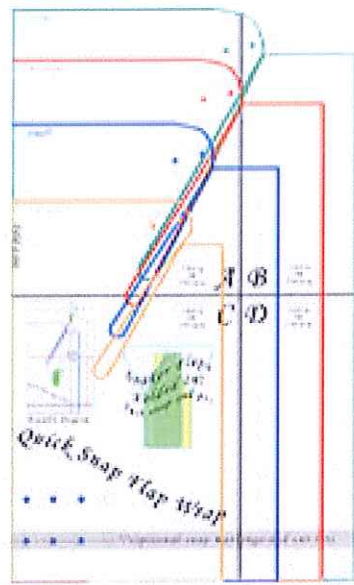
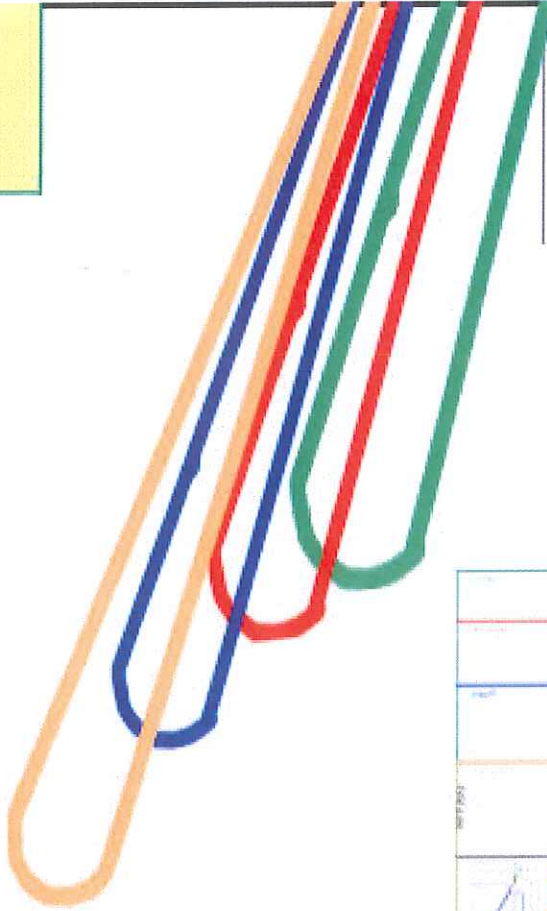

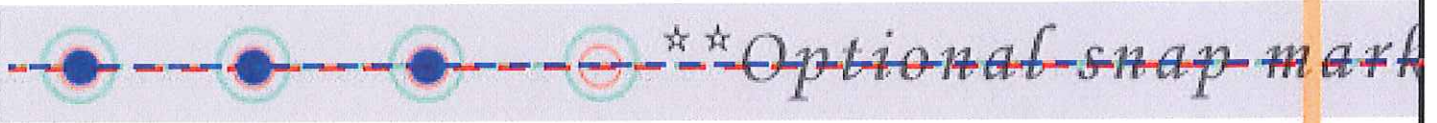


Quick Snap Flap Wrap

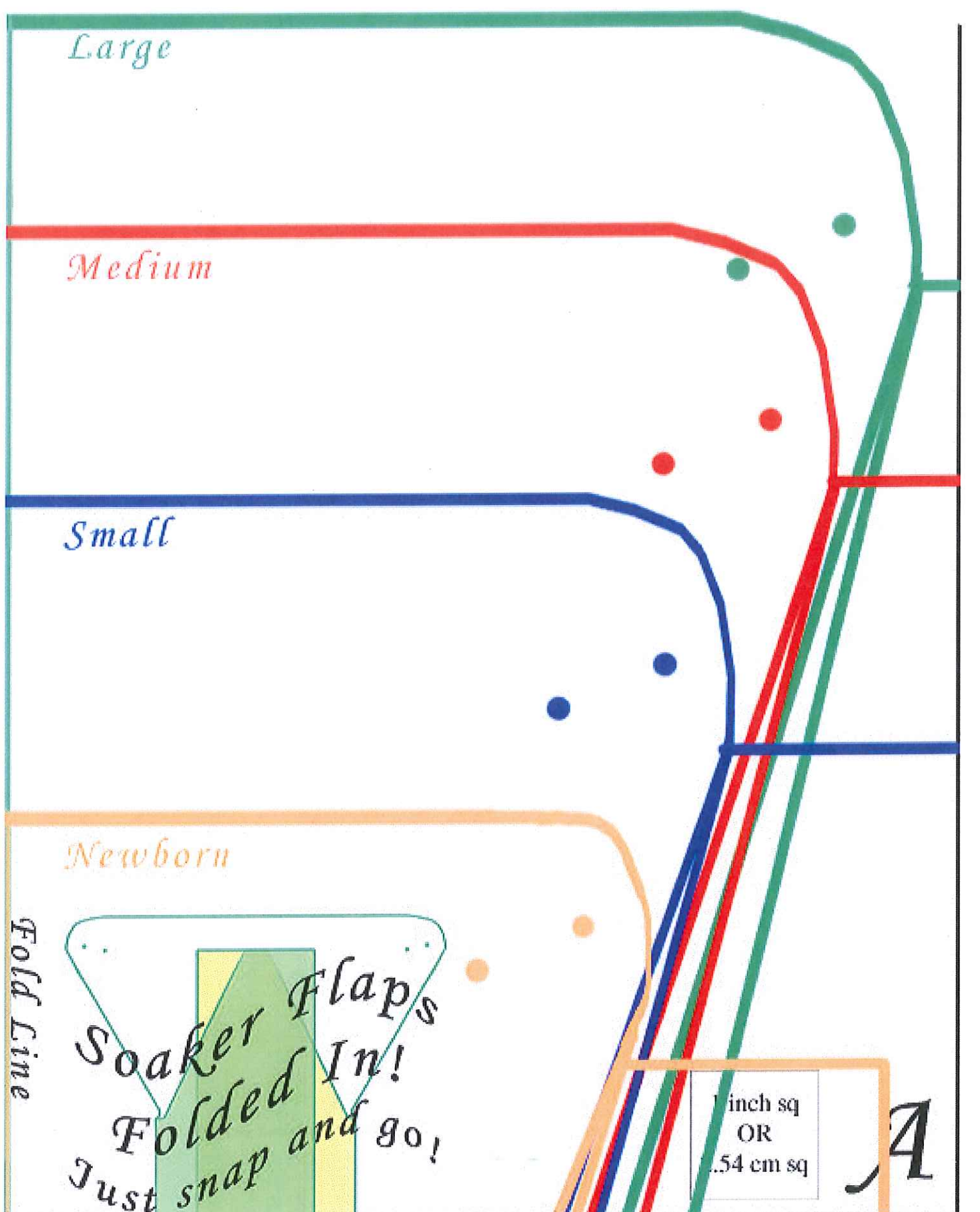

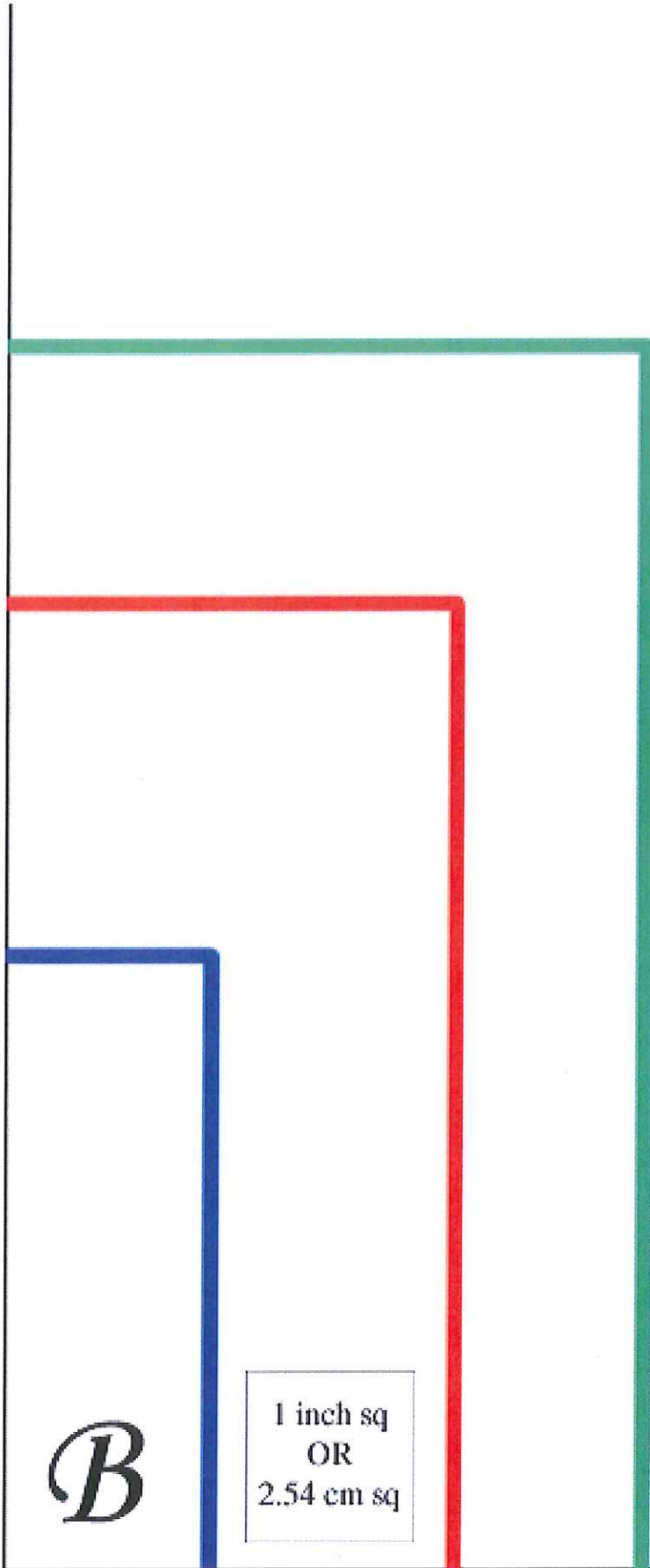

Quick Snap Flap Wrap (QSF^W)

Quickie instructions: Assemble the pattern and trace onto a double layer of absorbent fabric (wrong sides together). Cut ~1/2" outside the line and serge on the line all around the wrap. Add snaps (front snaps are color coded to the size lines). Now wrap those flaps and snap the snaps -- DONE! (A doubler, if needed, fits handily under the flaps, too.)

Alternate turn and topstitch instructions: Trace pattern on fabric (right sides together) and cut ~1/4" outside the line. Stitch on the line, leaving an opening for turning. Turn and topstitch the entire wrap, stitching turning opening closed. Add snaps (front snaps are color coded to the size lines). Now wrap those flaps and snap the snaps -- DONE! (A doubler, if needed, fits handily under the flaps, too.)

Optional snap marks and cut lines: If the rise is too low, use the alternate snap marks instead (or in addition to) of the lower markers. If the snaps are too low and folding over the top is a bother, cut the pattern at the optional cut line to reduce the extra front fabric.

*Handy hints: **Round off the corners of the pattern for easier serging. **Yes, hook and loop (TouchTape, Aplix, Velcro) can be used instead of snaps! Just line it up with the snap marks, making sure to add a laundry tab for the hook on the wings. **If your fabric is thinner, feel free to use 3 layers instead of 2! **When adding seam allowances for turn and topstitch, the cut lines where soaker and wings join may need to be redrawn to allow an adequate seam allowance. **Using knit fabrics adds stretch and can extend fit. **Fit too baggy? Add a length of soft elastic to the center back outer. **Stay tuned for a side fastening fleece cover pattern that uses FOE and combines perfectly with the QSF^W!*
