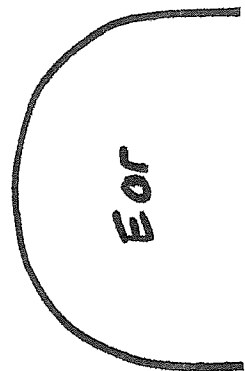
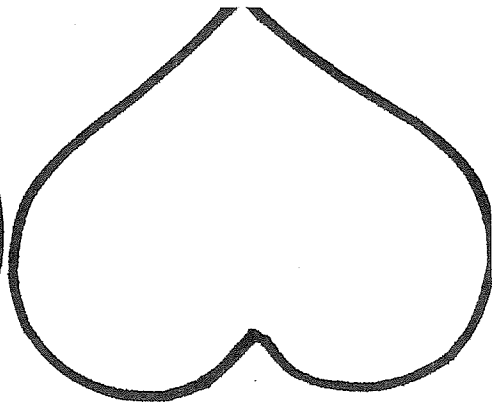

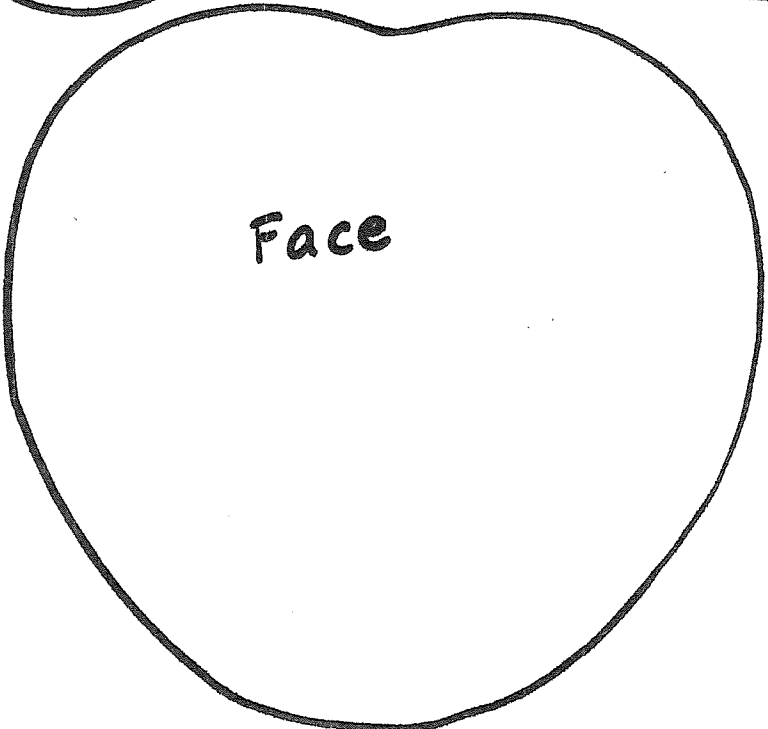

## Teddy Bear Instructions

Assembly Line Construction

### 1. Cutting Out Bear body:

- A. Layer 2 pieces of fabric, right sides out
- B. Right side is more colorful. Inside is smoother.
- C. Lay out 4-5 patterns
- D. Stand bear up across top alternating head up and head down, across bottom lay bear on side
- E. Pin head (ears), arms and legs
- F. Cut out 2 layers at once
- G. Cut out loosely
- H. Then cut out each bear individually
- I. Come from both directions at corners and meet at corner (be careful not to clip too far into corner)
- J. Make sure edges are smooth or can use pinking shears
- K. Save scraps for appliqués (if big enough)

### 2. Cutting out all appliqués:

- A. Use paper patterns
- B. Hold pattern- do not use pins
- C. Cut out one layer at a time

### 3. Sew ears, hands, feet, face(after complete) & heart(with label) on body:

- A. Pin on using pattern as guide (approx. 5/8 in. from edge, except heart)
- B. Pin & sew label on heart with straight stitch around all sides
- C. Anchor zig-zag stitch with 2-3 straight stitches at beginning and end
- D. Shorten zig-zag width: 2.5-3.1 W, 2.5L
- E. Use needle down
- F. Sew with appliqué on left

- G. Needle barely goes off right edge of appliqué
- H. Match thread color to appliqué
- I. Only pivot with needle down on outside (right) of appliqué
- J. Go very slow and stop and turn very often

**4. Sew eyes, pupil, snout, nose and tongue on face:**

- A. Shorten zig-zag to: 1.8W, 1.8L
- B. Use white thread in bobbin for eyes, pupil & snout
- C. White thread for eye & snout
- D. Thread to match pupil
- E. Use black bobbin for nose & tongue
- F. Black thread for nose
- G. Red thread for tongue & sew down all sides
- H. Use pattern for placement
- I. Will have to stop and pivot every 1-2 stitches

**5. Embroidery on face:**

- A. Use DMC perle cotton thread
- B. Use small backstitch stitch (overlap stitches slightly)
- C. Black thread for mouth (2-3 stitches between nose & tongue straight down, 4 stitches straight across tongue, angle 1 stitch up and 2 across end)
- D. Black thread for eyelashes (one stitch)
- E. White thread for pupil (one stitch)
- F. Look at pattern as a guide

**6. Sew bear front to back & stuff:**

- A. Lengthen straight stitch to 3.1L
- B. Use 3/8 inch seam
- C. Sew on right side of fabric
- D. Leave opening between arm and leg on one side big enough to get a hand in
- E. Stuff with poly-fil. Do not get too firm.
- F. Sew up side seam. Can use zipper foot if necessary
