When I think back over 2025, the word that comes to mind is celebration! I was blessed this year, along with several members of our U.S. and African Leadership Teams, to witness the drilling of the 2,000th well in HHI history. This means that approximately 3 million people now have access to life-saving water, but more than that, they have also been given the opportunity to encounter the Living Water... and that is certainly worth celebrating!

As you read through this report, you will see the amount of people impacted by your giving. Physical needs have been met through access to clean water, food sustainability, business education, school supplies, and disaster relief supplies. But ultimately, I want you to know that all of this has been done through partnerships with local churches, leading many to come to know the saving power of Jesus! In 2025, 94% of our international team indicated that they have seen positive changes in their local church since HHI started working in the community, with a total of 810 baptisms reported throughout the year. This is Kingdom growth and that is something to celebrate!

Thank you for continuing to partner with us as we continue to seek Kingdom impact in 2026!



# 2025 milestone unlocked: 2,000 wells



This year, the Clean Water program at Healing Hands International met a milestone of 2,000 wells drilled since our organization's inception. Thanks to your generosity and the hard work of Walk4Water coordinators, approximately 3,000,000 people

# CLEAN WATER

In 2025, the Clean Water program at Healing Hands International drilled 228 wells. According to population data in the countries we work in, these wells are less than one mile of approximately 717,567 people. Because of your contribution to Clean Water and HHI, over 700,000 men, women, and children are within a safe distance of drinkable water. That includes people affected by disease, disability, and economic disadvantage.

One of our favorite stories of transformation this year is from Oriver Zimba, a 54-year-old wife and mother of seven. When her village in Malawi received a well, she had this to say:

“I have raised all my kids from the dirty water from the river. This is the very first well in this village and we praise God for that. It was slowly becoming difficult for me to go to the river to get water. And we have a daughter, Esther, with a disabled leg. She could not go get water from the river, but now she’s able to do that here since it is near and flat land for her to walk. This makes our work easier because everyone, the old and the young, are able to draw water for themselves. It will completely change our lives. You have made us to be people with hope and experience the love of God. Thank you for this help! May God bless you all!”

The Clean Water program couldn’t have done it without the hard work and dedication of every person who participated in a Walk4Water in 2025. Thanks to the churches and communities that host Walk4Water events, the program raised \$1,355,195 to dig and maintain safe drinking wells for communities all over the world, from Uganda to India. HHI also celebrated our 2,000th well drilled this spring. Now, you can help us drill 2,000 more the years to come!

# HUNGER TO HARVEST

The Hunger to Harvest program at HHI exists to empower food security within families for generations to come. In 2025, more than 20,000 individuals were equipped to grow their own food through sustainable agriculture practices! Kufre in Nigeria attended one of these trainings and had this to say, "Losing my job was a devastating blow, plunging me into a dark period of struggle and uncertainty. But everything shifted when I received training from HHI. Today, I feel reborn. The training has empowered me to provide for myself and my loved ones. I'm financially stable, and my confidence has soared. Simple pleasures like buying bathing soap are no longer a struggle, but a given. I'm grateful to HHI for reigniting the spark within me. I'm proof that with the right guidance and support, anyone can overcome adversity and thrive!"

But Hunger to Harvest training does not stop at the garden level. Through second tier programs in animal husbandry, an exponential impact is being made. In Kenya, for example, when 10 families each receive a goat, the family will gift their first newborn to another family. Within 18 months, we would have a total of 400 families with goats! Goats are highly adaptable to diverse climates and require relatively low maintenance, making them an accessible livestock option for smallholder farmers across Africa. They provide multiple benefits: meat, milk, skins, and manure, all of which contribute to both nutrition and economic resilience. Because goats reproduce quickly and can be sold in local markets, they generate steady income streams that help families cover essential needs such as education and healthcare.

Can you imagine a world where no one has to go to bed hungry? Your support of the Hunger to Harvest program is helping us end the hunger crisis one village at a time.

# WOMEN OF HOPE

In 2025, more than 8,000 women received business and/or vocational education through the Women of Hope program, leading to the launch of more than 700 new businesses. Pushpa, a member of a women's group in India, had always wanted to start her own business but didn't know where to begin. She shared, "This training has opened my eyes. I learned how to identify good products, understand customer needs, and stand strong among competitors. Now, I believe I can start small and grow step by step. This training lit a spark in me. Now, I don't just dream of a business; I'm ready to build it with faith and confidence."

Once equipped with the skills and knowledge to start their own businesses, women like Pushpa often face another barrier: limited access to banking services. In many locations where HHI serves, the ability to have a savings account and/or access loan funds is nearly impossible, especially for women.

This is where the Women of Hope revolving loan program comes in. As of 2025, we now have revolving loan accounts established in all nine countries where our coordinators are working. These accounts allow individual women, as well as group businesses to access small loans to start their businesses. As these loans are repaid with low interest rates, the loan fund grows and more women are able to access the needed capital. Because of the program's success, more than half of the loans extended in 2025 came directly from previous loan repayments with no additional funds needed from the U.S.

In 2026, we are looking forward to deepening the work we are doing in communities where relationships are already established. By identifying groups and individuals who are already showing commitment to the principles learned, we can now go a step further with advanced skills training that will allow these women to not only survive, but truly thrive!





# THE MAGI PROJECT

In 2025, the MAGI Project shipped 28,467 MAGI Boxes to seven countries with the help of over 200 churches and groups. Every week, loyal, dedicated volunteers checked boxes, packed supplies, and maintained inventory. The impact of these boxes can be heard in this quote from Ecuador: "A little girl told her mother: 'Mom, God sent me notebooks from heaven.' That phrase reminded us of the true purpose: to show children that the love of Christ arrives in simple, but powerful ways."

MAGI's donor base also provided 5,535 Sponsor a Box gifts in nine countries, giving kids access to school supplies, clothes, and hygiene items in the name of Jesus. The Sponsor A Box program is committed to dedicating more resources towards this initiative which will directly impact children's ability to attend school by providing the items they need to succeed academically.

Our hope is that by meeting these practical needs, we not only remove barriers to education but also plant spiritual seeds—creating a ripple effect of joy, transformation, and discipleship within vulnerable communities.

Kondwani Betha, a student from Kawole Kasunga, Malawi, shared this with our international coordinator: "I am very thankful and very happy, as it is my first time to have my own school bag. As a grade 8 student, I have been carrying my school stuff in a plastic shopping bag. I am so grateful, as school has just started and I didn't have enough school necessities, because my parents couldn't afford them. We now have school necessities, groceries, and clothing."

# DISASTER RESPONSE

In 2025, Healing Hands International's Disaster Response program responded to 11 disasters, from earthquakes to famines, with supplies, resources, and financial support. Across 15 countries, communities received life-giving and resilience-building support to not only move past disaster, but flourish in spite of it. These 15 countries stretch from Eastern Europe to Southeast Asia to sub-Saharan Africa, and more: Ukraine, Kenya, Sri Lanka, Philippines, Haiti, Uganda, Tanzania, India, Jamaica, Myanmar, Turkey, Croatia, Zimbabwe, and Malawi.

After a devastating earthquake in Turkey, our partner Armağan had this to say: "I am sure that the Lord used even the worst event in some way. We are not afraid. Because for us, to die is joy. Truly, to die for the Lord is happiness. We thank HHI for their ministry. May the Lord bless them. And may they continue to pray as well. Thank you, HHI, for helping us. And thank you for everything. For faith. For helping us. Thank you for everything."

As HHI continues forward, the Disaster Response program is committed to preparing more communities with the necessary supplies, training, and networks to respond when disaster strikes.

The ministry of Healing Hands International is a beautiful manifestation of this verse. Because volunteering is such an integral part of HHI, we were proud to announce in 2025 that we are now offering a full VBS Curriculum to churches as a way to inspire and engage the next generation of believers in giving their time and talents to grow the Kingdom. This curriculum covers five of the Healing Hands International programs, using them as mission points designed to illustrate why and how we do things for others: We do them For the King. Each program is highlighted using a story from the Bible and gives students the opportunity to interact with the program in a hands-on way.

Our hope with this curriculum is that children will be exposed to the world outside of their communities and see that we are all called to serve those in need, and, most importantly, that they will understand why this calling is important: Everything we do, we do For the King. 
