

# Baby Blanket

## Quilts

Cut quilt backing 36" wide by 42" long  
(using flannel)

Cut quilt lining 33" wide by 42" long  
(using batting or random flannel)

Cut quilt top 33" wide by 42" long  
(using a piece quilt or printed fabric)

Put together, in the following order:  
Backing face down on bottom, batting or random flannel in the middle,  
and fabric choice on top.

You should have about 2-4" all around of backing fabric.  
Turn edges under and fold over quilt top, pinning as you go, making a point  
at the corners.

Sew around the quilt using a briar or zig zag stitch.  
Stop at corners and use a straight stitch to sew up to the point and back down  
to secure the corners.

Admire the beautiful quilt you have made for one of God's precious children!  
Say a prayer for the child who will receive your quilt.
