

Drawstring Marble Bag

Supplies:

Cotton or jersey Fabric (cut 6"x 16") *Note if fabric frays badly you may need to serge the edges or use a different fabric.

2 - 15" pieces of ribbon or cord for drawstring

Directions:

1. Cut out fabric to a 6"x16" and cut 2 pieces of ribbon 15" long each.
2. Turn one 6" side under $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Sew close to the inside edge to create a channel for ribbon.
3. Repeat on the other 6" side
4. Fold right sides together, matching the channels at the top. Sew sides but be careful not to sew channel closes. **START SEWING ABOUT $\frac{1}{2}$ " FROM THE TOP EDGE**
5. Repeat on the other side.
6. Turn the bag right side out.
7. Using a safety pin attached to one end of the first ribbon, run it through both channels of the bag so the ends come out on the same side. Tie a knot at the end of those ribbons. Now repeat with the other ribbon starting on the opposite side you did the first one. You will end up with a ribbon on each end of the bag. Tie a knot in the second ribbon ends. When you pull the ribbons the bag will tighten up. See image below.
