GLOBALLY,

785 million people lack a basic drinking-water service, including
144 million people who are dependent on surface water.
That's 1 in 10 people on the planet.
You can change this.

AROUND THE WORLD,

More than 2 billion people do not have access to basic sanitation. That's more than 25% of the world's population. You can change this, one village at a time. #Walk4Water

DID YOU KNOW?

Contaminated water transmits diseases such as diarrhea, cholera, typhoid, and polio. Contaminated drinking water is estimated to cause 485,000 deaths each year.
